Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438
Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110
dated 03.08.2016, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, at
Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

On 06.10.2016, this Court passed the following order;-

“C.M.No.32019 of 2016

This is an application for preponing the main petition.

*Heard. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same
is allowed.*

Main petition is taken up today.

*Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions, has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.10.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
