By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the respondents Nos. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against the respondent No. 4 to 6 who are trying to take illegal action possession by locking out the shop of the petitioner in connivance with each other.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 29.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Batala is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever

action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal
miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
