The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.338 dated 31.07.2016 registered under Sections 379-B read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The allegation against the petitioner was that he was sitting on the motor cycle boarded by three persons and snatched a mobile phone from the complainant during the course of snatching mobile phone of the complainant one of the accused Saurabh fell down and was arrested.

Learned State counsel as well as counsel for the petitioner state that the petitioner does not have any previous record of such offence. In that view of the matter, I think the petitioner should be given a chance to be at liberty. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-35463 OF 2016 is allowed.

- (ii) In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es)/victim.
