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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Venus A Singh in case FIR No.196 dated 04.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Kotwali, Patiala.

As per allegations, the present petitioner along with the co-accused husband Amarjit Singh have received huge amounts totaling Rs.25 lacs from five complainants, namely, Robin Garg, Jaskaran Singh, Babbu Salmani, Harwinder Kaur and Rana Mattu for sending them or their wards

to Chilly or Canada. Neither the passports and money have been returned nor they have been sent abroad.

Counsel for the parties heard.

It is not denied that the co-accused Amarjit Singh is still absconding and the petitioner is also stated to be not residing at the given address.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
