This petition has been filed by the petitioner for quashing of the complainant under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, and the summoning order dated 30.5.2013.

The precise ground taken by the petitioner is that in fact he is Tarsem Singh and the cheque was issued by some Tarsem Lal. The complaint was also filed against Tarsem Lal. Neither the petitioner has any dealing with the complainant nor has he bank account in that bank nor has he issued the cheque in question.

All these are questions of fact which cannot be gone into by this Court and can only be determined during the trial. Consequently, this petition is dismissed. The petitioner would obviously be at liberty to prove these facts during the evidence.
