The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 64 dated 16.06.2015 registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

The complainant is present in the Court today. The petitioner has joined the investigation. The parties had appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. When the case was referred for the first time it is stated that Rs. 10,000/- ordered by the Court had been paid to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not in a position to pay Rs. 50,000/-, therefore, he did not appear before the Mediator.

The complainant is present in the Court today. She states that she wants to live with the petitioner but not in the tenanted premises and she wants to reside in the house owned by the petitioner. She also states that the house is transferred by the petitioner in his sister's name and she has challenged that settlement. The petitioner states that he is ready to reside with the complainant

but he can only be in the rented accommodation as he has no other house, which

is not acceptable to the complainant.

The petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 08.10.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
