Instant petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioners and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of petitioners at the instance of private respondents as well to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Hans Raj, submits that after due enquiry into the allegations, FIR No. 337 dated October 07, 2015 under Section 346 IPC registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sadar has been recommended for cancellation and the same is likely to be presented in the Court of Jurisdictional Magistrate in a short period.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 to 11 that respondents No.4 to 11 have no grudge against either of the petitioners, who have solemnized their marriage as per their own sweet will.

4. In view of the afore-said aspects, instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

5. However, petitioners shall be at liberty to approach the court in case any need arises.
