Through the instant criminal miscellaneous petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner-Baljinder Kaur has sought direction to official respondents to carry out fair and impartial investigation pertaining to FIR No.191, dated October 08, 2014, under Sections 342, 323, 452, 506, 148 & 149 IPC, Police Station Jhabaal, District Tarn Taran registered at the instance of Kulbir Kaur as well as to carry out the investigation/inquiry against Rajwinder Kaur w/o Shavinder Singh and the erring police officials, who got registered a false DDR No.26, dated October 12, 2014, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 & 149 IPC, Police Station Jhabaal, District Tarn Taran by misusing the MLR of the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

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4. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied, in case, a necessary direction is issued to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (Punjab) to inquire into the matter unfolded by the petitioner in her representations dated 13.05.2016 & 16.05.2016 (Annexures P-3 to P-4) even subsequent thereto Annexure P-5 moved to the police authorities.

5. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that though number of representations have been moved way back in the month of May, 2016 and subsequent reminders, but till date no action has been taken.

6. The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the aforesaid representations (Annexure P-3 to P-5) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
