Petitioner is alleged to have introduced Raj Kumar to the complainant who cheated her by extracting money for recruitment of daughter of the complainant namely Jeevan Jyoti in Punjab Police. It has been urged by the counsel for the petitioner that the complainant and Raj Kumar had entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-2 on 17th October, 2015.

On asking of the Court, counsel informs that on the basis of investigation conducted by the Investigating Agency, challan has not been presented against Raj Kumar or the petitioner.

The present petition appears to be pre-mature. In case, on the basis of the material gathered during the course of investigation, on the complaint, the prosecution agency opts to present challan against the petitioner or Raj Kumar, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.

Disposed of as pre-mature without prejudice to the other rights of the petitioner.
