DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 48 dated 17.5.2015 registered under Sections 307,498-A and 149 IPC at Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was a dispute between husband and wife and vide order dated 3.12.2015, the petitioner was granted interim bail as there was possibility of compromise between the parties. He further contends that on that date complainant was also present in the Court and was duly verified by the Investigating Officer, ASI Major Singh.

Complainant-Nasim is also present in Court and has been identified by ASI Major Singh. She submits that now she is not having any grouse against the accused-petitioner as he is her husband. She also submits that she has no objection in case the petitioner is released on bail.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and by considering the fact that accused and complainant are husband and wife; the dispute between them has been settled; the complainant is now having no grouse in any manner and is happily residing in her married life, interim order passed by this Court on 3.12.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
