This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.124 dated 29.08.2016 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is neither the beneficiary nor had charged any amount for preparation of alleged forged and fabricated birth certificate in the name of co-accused-Vicky.

Heard.

The complainant in the present case is Regional Transport Officer, Jalandhar. As per the allegation, the petitioner charged ₹15,000/- for preparation of the document in question. His assertion that amount of ₹.15,000/- was retained by him and the whole amount was handed over to co-accused, Sharma cannot be accepted at this stage.

The allegation of supplying the wrong information to the Passport Authorities is very serious issue.

Keeping in view the serious nature of the case, no case for grant of concession of anticipatory bail is made out at this stage.

Consequently, bail application stands dismissed.

Anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
