Prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.159 dated 14.07.2014, under Sections 341/323/148/149 of Indian Penal Code (Section 302 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Occurrence is stated to be of 13.07.2014 during the late evening hours. Surjit Singh is the deceased who is stated to have been assaulted by the present petitioner as also six other co-accused armed with dang and sticks. Surjit Singh is stated to have succumbed to his injuries on 17.07.2014.

As per allegations, there was previous enmity between deceased and co-accused Gurpreet Singh @ Guggi as also Bholu.

In view of the nature and gravity of offence, no case for grant of bail is made out.

However, keeping in view the facts that the petitioner is in

custody since 21.07.2014 and the charges in the present case having been framed on 04.09.2014 and that out of 11 prosecution witnesses 07 having already been examined, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and to in any case conclude the same within a period of six months from today.
