Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.33 dated 20.2.2013, under Sections 307, 120-B and 34 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City, Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural (Annexure P-1) and the consequent proceedings arising thereof on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Darshan Singh states that after conducting investigation in the case, the police is in the process of filing untraced report. This satisfies the claim of the petitioners at this stage.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.
