By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short "Cr.P.C."), petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of their arrest, pertaining to FIR No.138, dated 28.08.2016, under Sections 324, 34 IPC (326 IPC added later on), Police Station Samana.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 26.11.2016, in compliance of order dated 04.10.2016 and 04.11.2016.

3. Moreover, parties have already patched up the matter and have settle their differences. The petitioners have also preferred CRM-M-37896-2016 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR on the basis of

compromise. So, in the given circumstances, it would not be desirable to decline the relief claimed by the petitioners.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.10.2016 and 04.11.2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial but subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
