The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.116 dated 06.06.2016, registered under Sections 379, 447 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Kotwali Patiala.

Heard.

On 05.10.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was admitted to interim bail but the same was not communicated to him. Accordingly, the petitioner could not join investigation and absence of the petitioner was not deliberate and intentional.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*

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authenticity of this document
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2. *That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
3. *That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.10.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
