The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.26, dated 4.3.2014, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS
Act, at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that bail was cancelled
only because the petitioner was sought to be served on the wrong address
and the order declaring him as proclaimed offender has been set aside by

this Court in CRR No. 3932 of 2016.

Counsel for the respondent has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court, he shall be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction.
