Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 not to interfere in the civil disputes of the petitioners and respondents No.7 to 12 at the behest of respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that representation (Annexure P-6) given by Baljeet Singh, Surjeet Singh and Baljinder Singh, to Director General of Police, Punjab, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2/Director General of Police, Punjab is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-6) and pass appropriate order within two month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, as per law.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
