The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.29 dated 28.2.2016, under Sections 451, 323, 148, 149 IPC, PS Maqsudan, District Jalandhar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 7.11.2016, report of the learned JMIC, Jalandhar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
