The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 to 5 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala in FIR No.57 dated 03.06.2016 under Sections 406, 498A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala, vide orders dated 20.08.2016 (Annexure P-1 to P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner was harassed by respondents No.2 to 5 on account of bringing less dowry. He further states that husband of the petitioner and respondent No.2 to 5 in connivance with each other cheated the petitioner because her husband was already married with German girl in the year 2005. On this ground, petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted by the trial Court.

A perusal of the order dated 20.08.2016 shows that no dowry articles were given at the time of marriage and the petitioner had never treated the complainant with the cruelty and nothing was to be recovered

from the petitioner. Respondents No.2 to 5 have joined investigation and abide by the terms and conditions under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, learned Addl.Sessions Judge, Patiala, had rightly granted the concession of anticipatory bail to respondents No.2 to 5 vide order dated 20.08.2016 and no ground is made out for cancellation of the same. The present petition seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail qua respondents No.2 to 5 is dismissed.
