Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in FIR No.24 dated 08.03.2016, under Sections 399, 402 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 08.03.2016. Co-accused of the petitioner Harmel Singh has been granted concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 26.09.2016 (Annexure P-3).

Learned State counsel informs that the petitioner is in custody in two other criminal cases of similar nature.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the other criminal cases against the petitioner, it is sufficient to observe here that similarly circumstanced, co-accused of the petitioner has been granted concession of bail by this Court.

Recovery has already been effected. The witnesses being official witnesses, likelihood of tampering with the evidence is remote.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of, during the entire period of trial.
