This is second petition for quashing of FIR in a case which was registered in the year 2011, first having been dismissed as withdrawn on 06.04.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the complainant had been pursuing the case through his father Karnail Singh who has since died and Iqbal Singh, himself, is residing in USA. The petitioner is being tried on the charge that he had cheated the complainant by preparing a false matriculation certificate in the name of Rajwinder Kaur wife of the complainant.

There appears to be a matrimonial dispute amongst Rajwinder Kaur and Iqbal Singh. The petitioner has been involved being brother-in-law of Rajwinder Kaur, who had been found innocent.

Though sufficient ground is not made out for quashing of the proceedings but the circumstances of the present case do warrant the exercise of powers under Section 483 Cr.P.C. for expeditious disposal of the case by the trial Court.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that trial Court

shall give short dates of hearing and make an earnest endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of six months, after the next date of hearing.
