This is a petition for quashing of the order declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender on the ground that not only the matter has been compromised between the parties but in an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C, this Court has passed an interim order requiring the petitioner to be released on interim bail on his joining investigation on or before 05.11.2016.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 05.11.2016.

On account of petitioner having already joined investigation, the order declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender would cease to have any effect.

With above observations, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

The proceedings consequent to declaring of the petitioner a proclaimed offender, will cease to have any effect henceforth without prejudice to the petition filed by the petitioner in CRM-M-37823-2016 pending for 14.12.2016.
