Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Baljit Singh Bakshi in case FIR No.219 dated 13.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 304 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Tripri Town, Patiala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that during pendency of the present petition, the informant and his mother i.e. the son and wife of Gurdial Singh (since deceased) have sorted out the dispute and effected a compromise with the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the

interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Hardeep Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 27th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
