After arguing the case at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the executing Court in which the mesne profits were deposited under the orders of the Courts. The proceedings have attained finality as no appeal etc. is pending and the decree has also been executed. However, the executing Court ordered that the

mesne profits deposited before it, would be released only after the disposal of this revision petition.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the executing Court in which the amount on account of mesne profits has been deposited for releasing the same.
