The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.70 dated 13.08.2016, under Sections 458, 354 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 21.10.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, therefore, the said order granting him interim bail may be confirmed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the concerned Investigation Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the

custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for the custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 21.10.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
