The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 7 dated 15.01.2015, under Sections 21,22,29,61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985 registered at Police Station, Barnala, District Barnala.

Heard the submissions made by Mr. Munish Raj Chaudhary, Advocate representing the petitioner and Mr. Neeraj Sharma, AAG, Punjab, representing the State.

The allegation against the petitioner is that 50 bottles of intoxicant liquor Rexcof were recovered from him. The petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2015 and the trial is still likely to take some time to

complete.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case the petitioner is admitted to regular bail during pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Barnala.
