**Kuldip Singh, J.** (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.143 dated 14.7.2012, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant-injured as well as the accused. The complainant as well as the accused have stated that they have effected compromise voluntarily and without any pressure.

As the parties have settled their dispute and there is no likelihood of conviction of the accused, therefore, FIR No.143 dated 14.7.2012, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
