Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of direction to the respondents to hold a fair investigation by transferring/handing over the investigation in the case, to Crime Branch or any other independent agency.

It is the case of the petitioner that respondent no.6 – Jai Bhagwan was appointed as Civilian Driver in Indian Air Force at Air Force Station, Sirsa on the basis of fake driving licence and fake experience

certificate and he is continuing, as such, despite the fact that he has committed a fraud in procuring a fake driving licence.

Respondents no.1 to 5, 6 and 7 have filed their respective replies and have controverted the allegations made by the petitioner.

In para 2 of the reply filed on behalf of respondents no.1 to 5, it is stated that in view of the reply filed by the employer of respondent no.6 vide letter dated 11.10.2013 (Annexure R-1), no commission of criminal offence is made out. It has further been averred that the employer of respondent no.6 has not moved any complaint against him to the local police. Rather, it has been stated that as per the investigation conducted by his office, the driving licence No.1548/F dated 22.1.1990 issued by the office of District Transport Officer, Ferozepur to the petitioner was found to be valid. When employer of respondent no.6 has not moved any complaint against him and during investigation, the driving licence of the respondent No.6 was found valid, the prayer of the petitioner cannot be accepted.

In this view of the matter, this Court finds that the present petition is devoid of any merit.

Dismissed.
