HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Petitioners have filed the present petition for issuance of direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their lives and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that now there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, learned State counsel has produced the copies of statements of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 and 5 i.e. father and mother of petitioner No.1. On the strength of these statements, so recorded, learned State counsel submits that petitioners do not have any threat to their life and liberty. Similarly, respondents No.4 and 5 have undertaken not to give any threat and rather accepted their marriage. The

statements made by the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 and 5 are taken on record.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioners still feel any danger to their lives, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar.
