Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 15.9.2016 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur. He further states that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2 is directed to look into the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation dated 15.9.2016 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in case the said representation is not received by the respondent No.2, it shall not be necessary for him to pass any order.
