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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.59 dated 24.07.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, under Sections 307, 452, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has only raised 'lalkara' and he was otherwise empty handed. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further argued that the petitioner has already undergone almost three months.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Tarsem Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it

appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.
