In view of serious allegations against the petitioner that he had fired shot at deceased Gurwinder Singh, I do not find any ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 09.10.2012.

Taking into consideration the said duration, in the interest of justice, a direction is issued that the prosecution agency would produce the entire evidence within a period of five months from the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court. The trial Court would give short dates of hearing and would make earnest endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of six months. In case, the trial is not concluded within said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
