Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 22.05.2016 under Sections 399 and 402 IPC as well as Sections 8, 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardayal Singh, submits that another case bearing FIR No.74 dated 28.12.2015 under Section 392 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural) is already pending against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of the cases registered against the

petitioner, no ground is made out for grant to anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
