Through the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of their arrest, in case bearing FIR No.288, dated 13.08.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 273 IPC (Section 407 added later on), Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, has fairly conceded that in compliance of order dated 26.10.2016, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

3. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 26.10.2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial but subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
