This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.104 dated 12.04.2016, under Sections 346, 365, 506, 376, 342 IPC, registered at Police Station, DLF, Phase I, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

As per allegations set out in the FIR, the complainant is husband of the prosecutrix, who is 26 years of age. The prosecutrix had accompanied the present petitioner for three months to Gurgaon, Jaipur, Pushkar, Haridwar, Kotdwar, Rurki, Delhi and Siliguri. Thereafter, she was recovered from the company of the petitioner.

This fact is not being disputed by learned counsel for the State that the prosecutrix had been in the company of the petitioner for about three months and had visited the above stated places.

Learned State counsel has informed that challan in the present

case has already been presented and the trial is fixed for framing of charges.

Petitioner is in custody since 11.05.2016.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.
