By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to interfere in their matrimonial life at the instance of respondents No.4 to 10.

On instructions from ASI Major Singh, Police Station Badali, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that after issuance of notice of motion, petitioners, namely, Manjeet Kaur and Jaspreet Singh appeared and furnished a sworn affidavit that they have solemnized the marriage and are living together as per the will and consent of their parents and further that they have no danger or apprehension to their life and liberty at the hands of these respondents as such, they do not require any security.

In view of the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.
