Report dated 31.05.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jaspal, Gurdev, Paramjit Singh, Gurdeep @ Pardeep Kumar, Sanjeev, Gurmeet, Charanjit as well as of complainants Pyari Devi and Kuldeep Chand it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in

nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, FIR No.171 dated 25.09.2015 under Sections 452,147,148,149,323,506 IPC Police Station, North, U.T., Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
