Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to register an FIR against the private respondents No.4 to 8. Prayer has also been made to issue a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states for the relief of registration of the case, she does not press the same. However, she states that for the aforesaid relief of protection of life and liberty, the petitioner has already submitted a representation (Annexure P-1) to the Director General of Police, Punjab. She further states that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran is directed to look into the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

It is made clear that the respondent No.2 shall consider the claim of the petitioner only to the extent of her life and liberty.
