Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their

parents. Petitioner No.1 stated to be major but petitioner No.2 is stated to

be 17½ years old. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of the Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 17.09.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Adhaar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting her date of birth as 15.03.1999. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and commenting on the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
