Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to provide adequate security at his shop and further to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation (Annexure P-5) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3-the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
