JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 20.05.2014 for the offences punishable under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran (**Annexure P-1**).

There is a recovery of 260 grams of *Intoxicating Powder*, which as per the FSL Report, contains *Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride* of a percentage, which is concededly commercial in nature.

The petitioner was stated to be taken into custody on 20.05.2014 and was granted interim bail on 21.10.2014. Thereafter, on receipt of Chemical Examiner Report, he was again taken into custody on 31.08.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by S.I. Rana Ranjit Singh, submits that 01 out of 07 prosecution witnesses has since been examined and the case is now listed for 01.03.2016.

Keeping in view the seized contraband being commercial in nature, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
