JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking for quashing the proceedings under Sections 81 and 82 of Cr.P.C. and other P.O. proceedings initiated against the petitioner due to his non appearance in case FIR No.98 dated 27.10.2011 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rahon, Distt. S.B.S. Nagar.

Complainant has filed instant FIR against three persons i.e. his father-in-law, mother-in-law and uncle-in-law. Petitioner is uncle-in-law of the complainant.

Since another petition has been filed by all the three accused for quashing FIR on the basis of compromise, has been allowed and FIR quashed with even date order.

In view of compromise arrived at between the parties in *CRM-M No.27262 of 2013* titled as *Baldev Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another*, the present petition has become rendered infructuous.
