This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 130 dated 27.08.2016, registered under Sections 354, 354-B and 323 of the IPC at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

On the statement of Karamjit Kaur wife of Tarlok Singh, neighbour of the petitioner, an FIR came to be registered under the aforesaid sections with an allegation that the petitioner had picked up a *Faurha* (a wooden spade) and had injured the complainant with the same.

By an order dated 07.10.2016, the interim protection was granted to the petitioner and he was directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and alleged *Faurha*, used in the said incident, has been recovered and thus no other recovery is to be made.

In view of the above fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and noting more is to be recovered, the instant petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.10.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
