The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 26.05.2015 in a case registered at the instance of Gajjan Singh alleging that on 14.05.2015 when the complainant along with Murari, Cleaner of the truck, was going with Grocery items loaded in the truck towards Gawalior, one pick-up vehicle waylaid the truck and 3-4 young boys alighted from the same, entered into the truck and forcibly made the complainant and Murari to sit in the vehicle. One co-accused drove the truck and after roaming the whole night, complainant along with Cleaner Murari were thrown in forest area and robbed the truck along with mobile phones and documents.

The evidence to connect the petitioner with the crime is the confessional statement made by the petitioner while he was arrested in a case under Arms Act on 26.05.2015.

The complainant and Cleaner Murari have already been examined. The chances of tampering with the evidence henceforth are not feasible. Seven witnesses out of 15 have been examined as such the

trial will take some more time. Petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature as per the instructions of ASI Mohinder Singh. In view of the said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
