This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.132 dated 10.11.2015, under Sections 363, 366, 304 IPC, registered at Police Station, City Gurdaspur.

The petitioner and the deceased daughter of the complainant were students of the same college and she had accompanied the petitioner from Gurdaspur to Mumbai. She was major at that time. On account of being patient of high diabetes, she had died in a hospital at Mumbai. As per report (Annexure P-5), cause of death of the daughter of complainant was due to diabetes.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that out of 15 prosecution witnesses, 03 have been examined before the trial Court.

The petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2015.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
