This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 114 dated 05.08.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Machhiwara, District Khanna.

By an order dated 07.10.2016, the interim protection was granted to the petitioner and he was directed to join the investigation.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that during the interim period, the parties have resolved their disputes amicably and are residing together.

On instructions from ASI Mandeep Singh, this fact has not been disputed by the counsel for the respondent-State.

In view of the above fact, the instant petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.10.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required

by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
