JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/husband in case FIR No.251 dated 08.12.2005, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

As per the allegations, the complainant-Jatinder Kaur and the petitioner/husband/accused-Charanjit Singh had solemnized their 2nd marriage on 16.05.2005 at Faridkot. Subsequently, due to matrimonial dispute, the aforesaid FIR was lodged by the complainant. The complainant was also harassed at the hands of petitioner along with his family members for demand of dowry articles.

The petitioner is stated to be declared as proclaimed offender in the year 2007 and surrendered before the trial Court on 31.03.2015 and since then he is in custody.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has already been acquitted by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
