INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.753 dated 01.09.2016,
registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra, under
Sections 323, 325, 326, 341, 506 and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in
appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested this
petition. Respondent No.2 also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned State
counsel; learned counsel for respondent No.2 and have gone through the

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record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not now required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Compromise has already been effected between the parties and petition for quashing of FIR is already pending in this Court, as argued.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The interim order dated 06.10.2016 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
