FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

It is *inter alia* argued that petitioner-Amrik Singh as well as respondent No.4-Amanpreet Kaur had entered into a wedlock on 30th March, 2016 and has placed reliance on Annexure P-2 and has contended that it was a joint petition by both of them. This Court vide orders dated 4th April, 2016 (Annexure P-2) has granted protection of life and personal liberty to them and that now on account of some personal matrimonial dispute, respondent No.4-Amanpreet Kaur has levelled false allegations of rape against the petitioner.

Notice of motion to official respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurveer Sidhu, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

The petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the application earlier moved by the petitioner to the police in the light of the scenario detailed above and to ensure that the petitioner is not unnecessarily put to harassment.
