Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for directing the respondents to conduct the investigation of the FIR No.264 dated 6.11.2015 under Sections 302/323/148/149 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at P.S. Narwana Sadar, District Jind in a fair and proper manner.

When this Court was not inclined to interfere into the matter, which is at advance stage, learned counsel for the

petitioners submitted that the respondents be directed to decide the representation dated 4.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted by Brijbhan, who is husband of petitioner no.1.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case whatsoever, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take note of the representation (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.
